



## **Matthew Chapter 6 — More of the Sermon on the mount.**

*In Matthew 6, Jesus teaches us to do good things quietly, not just to get attention from others. He shows us how to pray by giving us the Lord's Prayer and reminds us that God knows what we need even before we ask. Jesus also tells us not to worry too much about things like food or clothes, because God takes care of us just like He cares for the birds and flowers. Most of all, He encourages us to trust God and focus on loving Him and others.*
